DETAILS DETAILED

Bullock was Senior Construction Manager of the five year effort to construct a \$7-million wireless network for Verizon Wireless in north Georgia. Included in the accomplishments were cellular tower site selection, design and purchase, site design, purchase of Motorola™ cellular equipment, zoning and installation coordination bidding, contract administration, site construction management and design management.

Verizon recognized Bullock's innovations for:

- Developing plans and processes that saved more than \$400,000 in construction costs in one year
- Establishing a project approval process that shortened schedules by 30%
- Hard bidding work to multiple contractors that lowered contracting costs
- Improving project safety, progress reporting and the recordkeeping process of cell sites
- Instituting Critical Path Method (CPM) Scheduling

ALSO

Verizon retained Bullock to manage the bid, design and construction of its Sugarloaf Network Operations Center, a \$4 million nearly 16,000 square foot switch facility in Atlanta. Selections of the architect and general contractor as well as construction supervision were among the many details handled.

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
